Our program this morning was a highly informative presentation by Adrian Gutierrez and Christine Kokopelli who gave us some insight about how Covid-19 has affected their restaurants. Of course, it's been exceedingly difficult. However, both have learned new management skills. They both expressed extreme gratitude to all of us who have supported 3 Margaritas and Kokopelli Pizza. The best way to support these two wonderful businesses is to call them for food. They will deliver if requested.
