

Westminster 7:10 Rotary Club 2020 Scholarship Program

Scholarship Criteria: Scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$2,000 are available to high school seniors, attending high schools within the Westminster 7:10 Rotary Club service area. The scholarships will be based upon *academic achievement, leadership skills, community involvement, responses to the application questions*, and *a personal interview*. Scholarship finalists will be scheduled for interviews with the Scholarship Committee.

Scholarship Delivery: Awarded scholarships will be mailed via Westminster Rotary 7:10 Club check directly to the Financial Aid Office at the recipient's chosen school. <u>The scholarship</u> recipient must provide the name, address and phone number of the school's Financial Aid <u>Office</u>. Applicants awarded a scholarship will be expected to attend a Wednesday morning meeting to meet the Westminster 7:10 Rotary Club.

All scholarship applicants will be notified via email (*please provide an email*) of the receipt of your scholarship application and the final determination of the scholarship application.

- 2. A photocopy of your high school transcript; and
- 3. Letter of recommendatio.

You may answer the following questions by simply retyping onto another sheet of paper and forward to the address or email listed previously. Your response should be concise. You may use additional pages if you wish, although lengthy essays are not expected. Experience has shown most students can adequately answer the questions in less than one typewritten page.

- 1. Describe your community and volunteer activities.
- 2. Describe any other extracurricular school activities in which you participate.
- 3. Describe your work experience.
- 4. Describe your educational goals and any career aspirations.
- 5. Describe any honors or awards you have received, either in or out of school.
- 6. List any grants or scholarships you have received or will receive.
- 7. What other information about you will be useful in making the scholarship decision?
